

MINUTES FROM SOUTH CITY PRECINCT, 11TH OCTOBER 2011.

Opened with welcome to guests at 7.15pm.

- 1 Mr Dwight Kostusiak, A/Coordinator Traffic and Design gave a presentation of his ideas to ameliorate the congestion in the area of Galati's store, Wray Avenue, Manning Street, Carnac Street and Brennan Street. This was very helpful with several possibilities then discussed. Council has to abide by state and federal road rules but several options are possible. Dwight will talk to other local stakeholders in the vicinity. (Details available next meeting if required)
- 2 Three candidates for council elections; Ivan Dzeba, Rachel Pemberton and Michael Swanpoel, presented their ideas for council should they be successful. Each then answered questions from the floor.
- 3 The formal meeting proceeded; minutes from August meeting accepted.
- 4 Matters Arising
 - i) Freospace will replace leaflets in due course. Group encouraged to use the site.
 - ii) Wild Poppy sign. Apology from E Haynes that this matter has been neglected and will be addressed.
 - iii) Wray Ave. Planning report from June Hutchison. Nothing further to add, Paul Garbut stretched at present with demands of Local Planning Scheme/ Central City taking priority.
 - iv) June brought to our attention that there will be a series of community consultations for Planning scheme amendments, the first on 31st October at 6.30 in Victoria Hall. The eight identified sites, height limits etc will be discussed. These meetings will be advertised widely, including on Freospace. There will be open days, walking tours etc as part of the consultation process.
 - v) South Terrace/Wray Avenue roundabout; most agreed that this had finally reached a satisfactory conclusion and was working well. John Reeves-Burdam had forwarded a copy of his letter to council expressing disappointment that the new parking spaces created adjacent to the Diffens and directly opposite had been designated as 2 hour parking. It had been understood prior to the installation that these were to be only 30 minute parking bays. Chris Haynes

volunteered to write from Precinct to Council in support of John in this matter.

Other matters raised;

a) Need to check parking tickets as these are being placed on other cars.

b) Library AGM 6pm 2nd October.

c) Bicycle Users Group is encouraging students and parents to cycle to school safely (Fremantle Primary) and are seeking ideas to use some allocated funding. A paragraph will be placed on Freospace and through the school P & C.
